SCHOOL NURSE UPDATE



Head lice are small insects that live on a person's head. They are not a health hazard or a sign of poor hygiene. They only crawl and are often shared by head to head contact. If you are concerned about your child possibly having lice wash hair with lice shampoo for 7-10 days and comb hair daily. Lastly, ensure you are washing bedding, hats, coats, and towels in hot water and/or using high heat.
